#### INCOME CONVERSION:

- **Weekly Income x 52 = Yearly income**
- **Every 2 Weeks Income (Every other week, Bi-weekly) x 26 = Yearly income**
- **Twice a Month Income (Bi-monthly) x 24 = Yearly income**
